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## 12. NEGATIVE ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS, CONSTRUCTION

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The *REA* regulation requires that a Construction Plan Report be prepared to demonstrate how negative environmental effects of construction activities will be mitigated including modifications to construction activities, use of treatment technologies (e.g., Erosion and Sediment Control measures), and scheduling of activities.

Table 10 above provides the following:

- a description of performance objectives for significant natural features in light of potential negative environmental effects of the project;
- mitigation measures planned to achieve performance objectives;
- how the project is to be monitored; and
- a contingency plan to be implemented should monitoring reveal that mitigation measures have failed.

Table 10 has been prepared for inclusion in the Dufferin Wind Power Project Construction Plan Report. Additional mitigation measures proposed to minimize impacts of the facility and not related to natural features are summarized in the Construction Plan Report.
